SUBJECT: Request to add an item to the Review and Approval Process for 'Admission to the Major' requirements (formerly certification requirements)

The Registrar's Office is respectfully requesting that the Faculty Senate Steering Committee add departmental 'Admission to the Major' requirements to the list of items that can be streamlined. This seems wise for the following reasons:

- Catalog Subcommittee's philosophy is that departmental 'Admission to the major' requirements are under the department's purview, and therefore they do not need to spend committee time reviewing these requests.
- For the change to Rule 53 to be successful, it will be important that revisions to admission to the major requirements happen as efficiently as possible.
- As with other streamlined processes, the Registrar's Office will send these changes forward on an undergraduate major change bulletin, with the item noted as being streamlined. The process will be more efficient, and at the same time the information will be available for senate consideration in the usual manner.

For reference, please see the list of items below that the senate is already allowing the Registrar's Office to streamline, since 2016, based on support from the Catalog Subcommittee:

- Dropping majors, minors, certificates
- Expanding choices to fulfill degree requirements, if additional courses are offered by the college that offers the degree
- Name changes for majors, options, minors, certificates
- Degree requirement changes related to course number changes
- Degree extensions to other campuses, once approved by Provost's Office and assuming no curricular change
