SUBJECT:

Proposal to Revise Rules 9 and 102

At its meeting on October 23, 2018, AAC approved a proposal to eliminate Rule 9 and to revise Rule 102, prompted by a request from the Provost's Office.

AAC approved eliminating Rule 9 since the information duplicates what is embedded in Rule 114 on graduation requirements:

9. GRADE POINTS REQUIRED

Students entering with advanced standing must earn twice as many grade points for graduation as the number of hours which they have enrolled in this or any other institution.

AAC also approved the following revision to Rule 102 in order to update the language for clarity and uniformity of terminology. The revision also inserts a statement about the separation of the WSU GPA from the grade point average from other schools.

102. STUDENT'S SCHOLASTIC GRADE POINT AVERAGE

A student's scholastic average grade point average (GPA) is determined by adding the grade points earned in all WSU course work and dividing by the total number of credits hours in which the student has been enrolled at WSU. I, W, S, P, H, M, U, and X grades are disregarded.

The grades earned at other institutions do not count in the Washington State University grade point average.

At this time, Faculty Senate review and approval is recommended, to be effective fall 2019.
