The Department of Kinesiology and Educational Psychology is submitting documents requesting that the current PE_ACTIV prefix of all courses convert to the prefix of KIN_ACTV as attached. A number of PE_ACTIV courses will be eliminated.

At the end of this process, the PE_ACTIV prefix will be completely retired.

Rationale Statement

The Kinesiology Program would like to increase the course offerings of activity related courses. Transitioning PE_ACTIV courses to KIN_ACTV will allow the courses to include an activity-based component with progressive instruction under certified/qualified instructors. Moving PE_ACTIV to KIN_ACTV provides a department level identity and structure for the activity-based courses. The Department of Kinesiology and Educational Psychology is a good fit (home) for activity courses regarding shared facilities, resources, and teaching expertise.

KIN_ACTV will be the new course prefix - replacing PE_ACTIV. Activity courses will exist under KINES in the catalog. KIN_ACTV allows for the Enrollment Growth Funding model and moving from the current non-FTE model eliminates the extra "special" course fee of \$70 that students must pay for activity courses. This creates more affordable access for students to join activity courses.
