SUBJECT: Proposal to Revise the Grading Basis for the College of Pharmacy

At its meeting on February 20, 2019, the Professional Health Sciences Committee (PHSC) approved a proposal from the College of Pharmacy to revise the grading basis used for the professional courses offered under PHARDSCI and PHARMACY.

Prior to fall 2012, the College of Pharmacy proposed a new grading basis of H, S, F which was approved and which was to be used for all professional courses. Since that time, there has been recognition that some courses are more appropriately graded S, F, without the possible "Honors" grade.

The exhibits reviewed by the committee are attached, and the Professional Health Sciences Major Change Bulletin no. 3 presents several of the courses that show this grade change.

At this time, Faculty Senate review and approval is recommended, to be effective fall 2019.
