The 15 hour core is: TCH_LRN 333, 339, 401, 409, 413/414. 3 hours of electives are selected from TCH_LRN 404, 519, 516, or courses in other programs that are approved by the ELL Program Coordinator. A grade of C or better must be earned in all classes that apply towards this certificate. Few of the courses required for this certificate have prerequisites, but teaching experience or education classes are recommended.	<b>8-15</b>
