Master of Nursing in Population Health 2019 Proposed Changes

Rationale: The current MN is out of compliance with the Master's Essentials for accreditation. Currently the MN has 5 different curriculum options to obtain the MN degree MN: Education Track; MN: Leadership Track; MN: Population Health Track; MN: Generalist; MN in Passing for NP students. None of these options meet the accreditation criteria established by the Master's Essentials (AACN/CCNE 2015). The accreditation criteria indicate that all master's graduates have to have courses in nursing education, leadership, advanced patho/pharm/assessment, population health, etc. The current MN options divide education students to education courses only with no leadership or advanced assessment/patho/pharm content; leadership students have no education or advanced assessment/patho/pharm content; the population health students have no content in education or advanced assessment/patho/pharm content.

The **proposed curriculum** for the **MN** in **Population Health will now meet accreditation criteria** and hold the CON in good steed with reaccreditation visits by CCNE in April 2019. The MN revision eliminates all the individual MN specialty tracks (though certificate options are still available), uses the same courses previously approved for the MN degree (these have been submitted to the Registrar for major course curricular changes in course descriptions, student learning outcomes, and in some cases title and course credit change). The proposed degree program changes will not affect the faculty, students, CON, nor any campus where the MN courses are taught or received. No new courses have been added.
