I have been fortunate to be presented with the Faculty Award in the Honors College in 2006, to be the first recipient of the Office of Undergraduate Education's WSU Distinguished Teaching Award in 2009 and this year to win the College of Arts and Sciences first Excellence in Teaching Award. Additionally, I have worked with faculty, staff and students from the wider university while serving on VPLAC and the S & A Fees committee for several years. I am active in the Association for Faculty Women and next year will be President.

I believe that my commitment to academics and service make me a good candidate for the position of Executive Secretary.
