Commensal rodents are a serious pest and public health problem. Hear the latest from Michael Lee at the Vancouver Rat Project about rodents and potential risks to human health, as well as work on establishing a rodent surveillance program. Rodenticides are a commonly used tool in rodent management, but do you know how the rodenticides actually work? Dan Schlegel, Bell Laboratories, will discuss rodenticide modes of action and use for best results.
