

How to Find Courses

- Before your registration time begins, you can find out what courses will be offered by going to the [Schedules of Classes](#).
 - Select the term listed next to Pullman Campus.
 - Select a prefix from the list of prefixes.
 - All of the courses that will be offered for that prefix and term will be listed. Sections in gray are full or closed.
- When viewing courses in the Schedules of Classes, be sure to:
 - Select the **Section** link (01, for example) listed below each course prefix and number to review course registration details, such as start and end dates, the last day to drop the course, etc.
