

Suggested Advisor Promotion Activities/Involvement/Experiences

- Within the Unit/Department:
 - Developed advising initiatives/outreach activities that measure/analyze/impact retention, student progress or graduation rate (group advising, peer advising, e-advising, etc. that have received prior approval from supervisor)
 - Departmental committee work (service/coordination with dept. scholarships, undergraduate curriculum, etc.)
 - Assistance with enrollment or assessment (ex: providing OBIEE reports, collecting student data, teaching, club advising, internship or other experiential learning development, etc.)
- Within the College:
 - Assist with College Alive coordination (making sure all Alive sessions have proper coverage, coordinate backup when necessary, working closely with Ruth/Terese when issues arise, reporting Alive numbers to Ana Maria)
 - Assist with the annual CAS Student Satisfaction Surveys (updating Qualtrics link, updating questions when necessary, working with Arlene to input paper surveys, prepare reports for advisors/chairs for annual review)
