- UAAEC- No report.

- NRC Discussion-

Regarding the extension of the deadline for the NRC Grade applications for students. After January 6th, the original date, advisors were getting calls from students that they missed the deadline. The only option was to complete a petition. 20-30 petitions were already turned in for missing the deadline. Then a query was ran of students who were eligible for NRC, the largest groups of students that did not complete it were rural, low income, multicultural and men. This played a large part in the decision to extend the deadline to reduce the number of barriers to students. 1500 students down in enrollment to begin with, extending the deadline impacted more than 300 of those students. 900 students down in the end. Some advisors had not been communicated with very well regarding the deadlines and change of dates. We can improve our means of communication with advisors and students.

- Impact of grading policies on repeat class limits –

A current WSU Pullman student is looking into a transfer to Everett. Took an NRC Grade Fall 2020. Are these classes classified as repeats? ME class specific.
No, does not count towards student's repeat limit.

- Feedback from advisors – (Student and Staff Health and Wellness /Request for Transparency for Return to Hybrid/In-Person)

General feeling of low morale in College of Engineering- Students are saying they can hold on for one more semester, but not multiple in this current environment. What are the next steps or plans? Is there any communication out?

There is a Town Hall on 1/28. Talks of more face to face coming in the Fall. A lot of unknown still. Some students are reporting having a hard time getting ahold of departments. If there are departments, you are not getting hold of either phone or email please let the director know.

- CAS Questions re: Housing #s, RO program/plan change issues, adding WP status on AR reports, and listing Graduation Deficiency Lists in Advising Dashboard-

800 students for Fall, 1300-1500 for Spring. CAS advisors seeing some inconsistencies with the plan change form from the RO office. Only departments advisor can make the request to add a minor? Can the WP status be added to their academic requirements report? Can advisors access Graduation Deficiency Lists in Advising Dashboard?

Blaine will work on answers to these questions.

- Laptop Checkouts-

Can students still barrow laptops this Spring?

- Update on Dual Enrollment-

Email the campus registrar that the Pullman student wants to take class at (What Campus) and our RO. This is still the procedure. Working on how this can become more streamlined. The student cannot enroll themselves in dual campus, the RO must.

- Update on Navigate-

Request for proposal currently being worked on. Replace Navigate with an appointment scheduling system. We are not using the analytics portion of Navigate currently and this program is very expensive. 48% of advisors are using Navigate, 58% are not using the platform. Professional advising does not have access to Navigate. Looking for a new program to implement. Demos will be in Spring. Any change over will be taking place after the semester ends. Looking at 3-4 different demo options.
