Welcome to the Piano Pedagogy Laboratory School! I am glad you are interested in taking piano lessons with our enthusiastic teachers, and we cannot wait to work with you.

### **Organization**

The PPLS offers private lessons from September through April, arranged into a fall and a spring semester. Each semester comprises 15 weekly lessons and 1 final recital, where students will share the result of their hard work with their friends and family.

We ask students and their families to commit to at least one semester of piano lessons. Although we understand that sometimes other plans may occur, discontinuous lessons are counterproductive, and we know that students learn better when their lessons happen regularly. As our teachers commit to our schedule, we appreciate you doing so.

### **Fees for Private Lessons**

<b>WSU Piano Professors:</b>	contact Dr. Menchetti or Dr. Roh
<b>Graduate Teaching Assistants:</b>	30 min. lessons = \$ 262.50 per semester 45 min. lessons = \$ 393.75 per semester
<b>Undergraduate Student Teachers:</b>	30 min. lessons = \$ 225.00 per semester 45 min. lessons = \$ 337.50 per semester

### **Payments**

When students register at the beginning of the year, they are charged for the whole semester (15 lessons), but they can pay in three monthly installments. The installments do not reflect the exact number of lessons taken in a specific month, but a group of five lessons. The final recital does not count as a lesson, and it is free of charge!

The payments are due as it follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> installment by August 30
- 2<sup>nd</sup> installment by September 27
- 3<sup>rd</sup> installment by November 1

You can either

Please note that one missed payment will result in automatic termination of the lessons. Music books must be purchased separately by the parent or student. Your teacher will have recommendations and instructions regarding purchasing printed music materials.

### **Make-Up Lessons & Vacations**

There are no make-up lessons for either illness or school events. If you cannot be at a lesson because of illness or any other reason, please contact your teacher as soon as possible. If your teacher misses a lesson for any reason, it will be made up at a time convenient to both parties. If for any reason you cannot continue lessons, we require a four-week notification, or it will be the school's policy to charge the equivalent of next installment.

### **Recitals**

It is our tradition to involve students in several public performances since they are a vital part of their development. Considering the unpredictability of the current situation, as of now we are planning a Christmas recital and a Spring recital. We will be monitoring how the situation evolves, and we will inform you in case more opportunities arise. We certainly want our students to perform as much as they can!

### **Practice Expectations**

Students enrolled in 30-minute lessons are expected to practice a minimum of 20 minutes each day. 45-minute lessons require a minimum of 40 minutes practice each day. Students who wish to excel should allow for more practice time. Daily practice will help the student accomplish his/her musical goals, which will lead to greater self-esteem and the enhancement of learning abilities.
